## Instructions (for maximum durability):

- 1) DIP IN COOL WATER** before drilling and about every 5 seconds during drilling (more often when going through harder materials). We find dipping in cool water is more effective at cooling the Porcelain bits than spraying.
- 2) FIRM PRESSURE: Let the bit do the work - Do not apply excessive pressure.** Place the drill bit on the specified mark, apply pressure, listen for a slight CRUNCH, and start your drilling process. Drill straight into hole and do not wiggle drill.
- 3) USE PROPER DRILLING SPEED - Cyclone: 600rpms/Speedbit:2,300rpms** and slowed down while breaking through the hole. **NOTE THE HIGHER SPEED FOR THE SPEEDBIT AS MOST OTHER SPEAR POINT BITS RECOMMEND SLOWER SPEEDS OF 400-800 RPMS.**

- The Cyclone can be used in a Handheld or Hammer Drill. The Speedbit should only be used in a Handheld Drill.
- Do not use dull or damaged bit.
- Wear ANSI-approved safety goggles and heavy-duty work gloves during use and when handling bit.
